successful examination. For English, however, two-thirds are exacted.

An examination is considered *partially* successful when the candidate gains *one-half* of all attainable marks, and, for each branch, at least *one-fourth* the marks allowed for it.

No student will receive a Diploma of any kind until such time as his indebtedness to the Institution shall have been

satisfactorily settled.

N. B.—Former students, who graduated before the adoption of the present Programme of Studies, and who are desirous of receiving Degrees, will learn the conditions of their reception from the Prefect of Studies, with whom they should communicate by letter.
