The gold in the sea has been derived from the land, being brought down to the coast by rivers. Likewise the gold in the beach sand, which itself is the debris of inland

In some regions the mountains conin much gold, which is fetched down streams. Such gravels may be very h in what is called "alluvial" gold

Nowadays the stream gravels of California, and likewise those of the Yukon, are worked for gold by huge dredges, which, with huge scoop buckets mounted on endless chains banks, taking the gravel aboard, separating the gold from it by wasning and dumping the detritus overboard.

The principal by-product is pebbles. which are carried away from the posits them at a sufficient distance to be out of the way. In this manner small mountains of pebbles are built up—a waste output, but worth money for roadmaking and other purposes.
