An Act to avoid doubts as to a certain provision of the Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada.

HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the true intent and Preamble. meaning of the two hundred and forty-sixth section of the Act passed in the twenty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions Sect. 246 of 5 of Upper Canada, (22 Vic. c. 99,) as regards the application of 22 V. c. 99. the sums to be paid for Tavern Licenses: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
