An Act to extend the period limited for certain purposes in the Montreal Registry Act.

2 WHEREAS it is expedient to extend and continue Preamble. for a limited time, certain provisions of the Act hereinafter mentioned : Be it therefore enacted. &c.

⁴ and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, Period fixed that for and notwithstanding any thing in the Act passed in for cortain pur-6 the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign and intituled, c. 121, extend-" An Act to remedy certain defects in the Registration of cd. 8 " deeds and instruments relating to real Property, in the "Registry Office at Montreal," the period of twelve 10 months from the passing thereof, which is therein mentioned as the period during which the registration of certain 12 instruments may be efficiently completed in the manner in the said Act provided, and during which no error, 14 omission or irregularity on the part of Edward Dowling or his Deputy shall be held to render the Registration of 16 any Instrument incomplete or void, and during which certain-other things must or may be done under the said 18 Act, shall be and is hereby extended to the period of twelve months from the passing of this Act, and the 20 said Act shall be construed and have effect to all intents and purposes whatsoever, as if the period last aforesaid 22 had been mentioned in every part of the said Act, instead of the period therein mentioned and first aforesaid.
