## BILL

"sent from the Legislative Coun"cil, intituled "A Bill to repeal
"and amend certain parts of an
"Act passed in the thirty fourth
"year of His late Majesty's reign,

XPERIENCE having shewn that the Provisions of the Provincial Statute passed in the thirty-fourth year of the Reign of His late Majesty George the Third, chapter sixth, intituled "An Act for the Division of the Pro-" vince of Lower-Canada, for amending the " Judicature thereof, and for repealing cer-" tain Laws therein mentioned," have not produced the effects which were intended, and are evidently insufficient; May it therefore please your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An act to repeal certain " parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An " Act for making more effectual provision for " the Government of the Province of Quebec, in " North America," and to make further provi-" sion for the Government of the said Pro-"vince;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passing of this Act, the Superior and Inferior Terms of the Courts of King's Bench for Civil Causes in the Districts of Quebec and Montreal, established by the said Act of the 34th year of the Reign of His late Majesty George the Third, intituled " An Act for the division " of the Province of Lower-Canada, for amend-" in the Judicature thereof, and for repealing " certain Laws therein mentioned," shall be,
