Dear Sir:-

I have received during the past few months a number of Treasury cheques covering the Provincial subsidy on road improvements from the various Indian Reserves in Ontario for the year 1935. In the past you were good enough to supply the Department with a statement of expenditure upon which subsidy was based, but for the year 1935, I do not appear to have received such a statement. Has this practice been discontinued?

Our local Indian Agents have been asked to submit statements of road expenditure annually and these have been checked against your reports. This year we have no way of reconciling the amount of your contribution with the actual expenditure as the rate of subsidy varies and usually some reported expenditure is disallowed.

Although I do not wish to insist on these statements, you can readily see their value to the Department.
