In reply to your letter of the 25th ultimo, and with reference particularly to the question of residence on the Rocky Point Indian Reserve, I may say that this land was not purchased originally exclusively for the use of Alice and Louis Mitchell. It was understood at the time that these Indians were to have a life interest in the property, subject, however, to the right of the Department to permit other Indians to reside thereon if necessary. *W.A.C.*
