Automatic Vacation of office Sec. 31

Tentative holding for life
(subject to provisions of the Act) Sec. 29

Sec. 29 is subject not only to Sec 31
but also to Sec 18 whereunder
the Senator holds subject to
non-invasion of the privileges immuni-
ties and powers of the House.

The House, exercising its judicial power
(see May Chapter 2) may pronounce upon
its privileges &c and decree invasion
of them. See also Feldman, Thomas (1896)
A. C. 600. and case cited therein (R. 10 P.C.
32 F-340.)

The proceedings of the House might
be confirmed by call of a Statute
enacted under Sec 18 of the B.N.A. Act
&c
