With reference to your letter of the 5th ultimo, reporting the rejection of the proposal made to the band for an extension of the time for the removal of the timber on the reserve at present under license to Mr. W. If it was owing to this cause, will you have the goodness to interview the Chief and Principal men of the band and ascertain their views respecting the amount they should receive by way of compensation for the proposed extension of time, and report the result of your inquiry to the Department.
