• Huron and Chippewa Bands to the Carleton Place
• survey in the County of Middlesex. You acted as
• solicitor in behalf of the said Chippewa
• Band, and succeeded in establishing the claim
• of said Band as against part payment was received
• from the said Department, with the promise that
• the balance due in favour of the Band, would
• be settled in full in two years time. You are
• well aware that quite a number of years have
• elapsed since the part payment was made, and the
• Band is anxious to know how long before the balance
• will be settled. It would not be possible that
• you, after receiving your 25% fee from the Band
• in the prosecution for the establishment of its
• claim and that you had succeeded to a certain
• extent, and that you would see through the case
• of your clients.
