Under the Consolidated Regulations respecting  
Trading with the Enemy (1939), just issued, enemy territory  
and proscribed territory are defined as follows:-

" 'Enemy territory' means any area which  
is under the sovereignty of or in the occupation  
of, a State or Sovereign for the time being at  
war with His Majesty."

" 'Proscribed territory' means any area in  
respect of which the Governor in Council by reason  
of real or apprehended hostilities or otherwise,  
may order the protective custody of property of  
persons residing in that area and the regulating  
of trade with such persons."
