ACES OF ALL NATIONS

Having examined their methods, peculiarities, and their characteristics, which account for their proved superiority both over their enemies and in comparison with their comrades, let us look at the complete score of the Aces of aviation of all the belligerent countries.

This score I have been tabulating since the war in the air began, and it is officially correct up to the date of August 1, 1918, with the exception of the list of British Aces, whose records are not made public until His Majesty is graciously pleased to confer upon them the Victoria Cross or the Distinguished Service Order for some extraordinary and brilliant performance of duty. Many British Aces must, therefore, be omitted from the following table.
