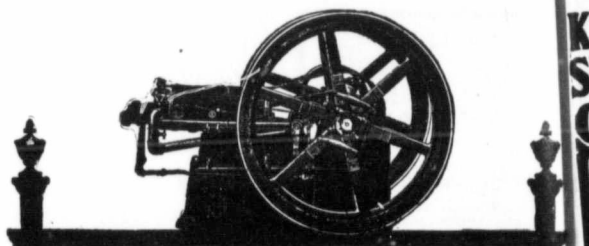
This diversification has permit-

been in some sections over fifteen
thousand bushels of wheat. If
the crop of 1910 had to be har-
vested by the method of our
grandfathers, it would require the
services of every man between the
ages of twenty and fifty for from
three to four weeks; but as the
wheat crop is now handled by
means of self-binders and headers
there is no difficulty in harvesting
the crop before damage is done it.
In all of the other stages of wheat
culture, including plowing, culti-
vation, seeding, threshing and
marketing, no difficulty is ex-
perienced and no risk of quantity,
or of labor to do the work is ever
run.

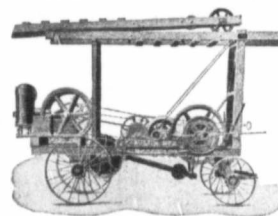
