

GREAT IMPROVEMENT —IN— WHEAT DRESSING

Extract from a Special Report which appeared in "Bell's Weekly Messenger."

"As the genuine article is so cheap, it is worse than folly to buy the stuff just mentioned, when the saving of cost only amounts to a few cents per acre."
