

IV. *And be it further enacted,* That the said Commissioners shall at the *first* court of General Sessions of the Peace in the said county of *Charlotte* yearly render an account to the Justices of the said Sessions of the monies from time to time received and expended by them under this act, and shall also, on completing the said Slip and Beacons, pay the ballance (if any) remaining in their hands into the county Treasury for the purpose of defraying the expences of keeping in repair such Slip and Beacons.

The Commissioners to account to the Court of Sessions,

and pay the ballance in their hands into the County Treasury.

V. *And be it further enacted,* That if any person or persons shall take away, cut down, destroy or deface either of the said Beacons, such offender or offenders shall on due conviction thereof by the oath of one or more credible witness or witnesses before any two of HIS MAJESTY'S Justices of the Peace forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding *twenty pounds* to be applied as aforesaid, and on failure of payment thereof or want of goods or chattels whereon to levy, such offender or offenders shall be committed by such Justices to the county Gaol for a space not exceeding *three months*.

Any offender convicted of destroying the said Beacons to forfeit a sum not exceeding 20l.

VI. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall continue in force for the term of *five years* and no longer.

Limitation.

C A P. VII.

An ACT further to continue an Act intituled "An ACT for raising a REVENUE in this Province."

I. **B**E IT ENACTED, *by the Lieutenant Governor Council and Assembly,* That an act made and passed in the *thirty third* year of HIS MAJESTY'S reign, intituled "*An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province,*" and by an act, made and passed in the *thirty fourth* year of HIS MAJESTY'S reign intituled "*An Act to continue an Act intituled, 'An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province,'*" declared to be continued in full force until the *first day of April* which will be in the year of our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Five and no longer; be further continued: And the same is hereby continued in full force until the *first day of April* which will be in the year of our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Six, and no longer; except for the recovery of any of the penalties inflicted in and by the *sixteenth* Section of the said act.

The act for raising a Revenue,

continued to the 1st. of April 1766. 1796.
