TO HIS EXCELLENCY SIR PEREGRINE MAITLAND, *Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Upper Canada, and Major General Commanding His Majesty's Forces therein, &c. &c. &c.*

The Commissioners appointed by your Excellency, in conformity to the provisions of two several Acts passed by the Legislature of this Province, for making a Navigable Canal for Vessels, between Burlington Bay and Lake Ontario—

Most respectfully Report—

That since your Excellency's visit to the work entrusted to their superintendance the beginning of July last, the completion of it has been proceeded in with all the expedition of which its nature was susceptible; and in order to lay before your Excellency a detailed statement of what has been done, and what remains to be done, they obtained the professional assistance of Mr. Barrett, an Engineer employed by the Welland Canal Company, a copy of whose reports they beg leave to submit, along with this, for your Excellency's information.
