

FIERCEST HOUR OF CONFLICT COMING

Long Drawn-out Battle Between Commons and Lords This Week

London, June 28.—(By T. P. O'Connell.) I need not remind you of the luminous accounts received from other sources in regard to the coronation. It was a great success and there were few additions during the procession in London. Considering the conditions, the arrangements were perfect. The reception of the King and Queen was enthusiastic. The crowds were not so overwhelming as was expected, and the exodus from London was hurried. Many people were worried by the excessive noise and impassable streets rushed to the seashore and golf links.

The approach of the fiercest hour of the long drawn-out conflict between the Lords and Commons next week will be indicated by the coronation and other events. It is generally expected that the political situation will be somewhat calm.

The veto bill will resume its consideration on Monday. The government will have a few hours after receiving them.

The Tories cannot live long with out some more. They are working at this moment over the declaration of London. The protectionists and yellow journals and all of the admirals have raised the cry that this declaration surrenders such important English rights of naval warfare as to threaten England with defeat in the first naval battles followed by universal starvation owing to the stoppage of ships bearing food to England.

This received a heavy blow from the Imperial Conference, representing all of the great nations, which declared the declaration. The battle now is transferred to the House of Commons and soon we shall have a debate and violent scenes there. The declaration will be carried by an unbroken coalition majority.

The second scene is a more ridiculous one. During the last week the report was industriously circulated that a new general election must come in August. This report was founded on alleged intention of the House of Lords to the amendment excluding home rule from the operation of the veto bill.

Everybody took it for granted that after the refusal of the lords to divide on the second reading of the bill and Rosebery's speech of disparaging appeal that the veto bill will be promptly swallowed after a byzantine process by the lords that they intended to fight to the bitter end.

Now new current has set in and the declaration is freely made that it will not shrink from facing Premier Asquith as they seek the King to create a new cabinet.

By the further report that Asquith was playing a game of bluff and had no guarantee from the King, who would enable him to create the new peers.

I attach little importance to this latest desperate cry. The fact that Asquith has the guarantee that he will create them if the veto bill is rejected and that the lords are only trying to make a last stand to save their own faces.

NATIONS' HOMAGE TO KING GEORGE

Great Naval Review of Ships of Eighteen Nations at Spithead

London, June 27.—One hundred and eighty-five ships of war representing eighteen nations, paid homage to King George V and his consort, Queen Mary, at Spithead today. Spread over a six mile stretch of sea were the fighting monsters all dressed in flags and bunting and presenting an unrivaled and many colored picture. It was a magnificent tribute to Britain's sailor king. As the King and Queen, on board the royal yacht Victoria and Albert, proceeded through the long lines of battleships, cruisers, and other vessels, each ship gave the royal salute.

The thunderous tones of the great guns were deafening. Included in the party aboard the royal yacht were distinguished envoys to the coronation festivities. Of the ships in the column one hundred and sixty-seven represented Great Britain and eight represented other nations.

There had been a great exodus to Spithead all morning. Thousands of Americans were in the van. At 12:50 o'clock when the royal train arrived at Portsmouth, the majesties were met by Admiral Moore, commander in chief of the British fleet and officers of the naval guard of honor. When the party had stepped aboard the royal yacht Victoria and Albert, the royal standard was run to masthead.

An officer on the bridge of the Lord Nelson's ship had been watching for this signal. Shortly after the standard had been hoisted the breeze then came across the water the signal to invite the party from an open port of the old flagship. Before the report of the gun had reached those on board the royal yacht, the signal was repeated.

TORONTO C. P. R. TRAIN DERAILED

HOPE OF DEFEATING TARIFF BILL SMALL

Inaugural Republicans Are Finding Themselves in an Embarrassing Position. The Train Has Been Derailed and the Bill Passed With Republican Protest.

Washington, June 28.—With the plain declaration by Republican Senators who have talked with President Taft that they will not support the tariff bill if additions are attached thereto, and the public announcement by the House of Representatives that they will not support the bill, Republican insurgents who have been dickered with the tariff bill are in a predicament.

They see all hope of defeating the Canadian bill going gingerly in the wings. The tariff bill is a measure which is opposing the Canadian agreement bill and at the same time advocating radical changes in the tariff law.
