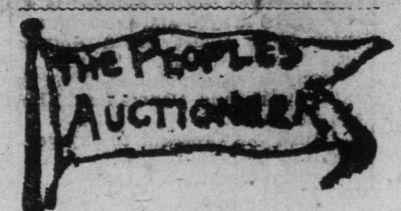

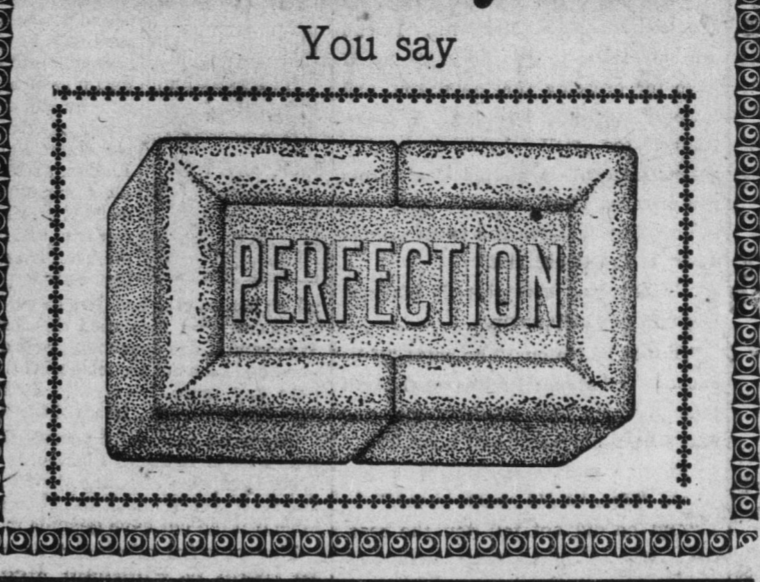

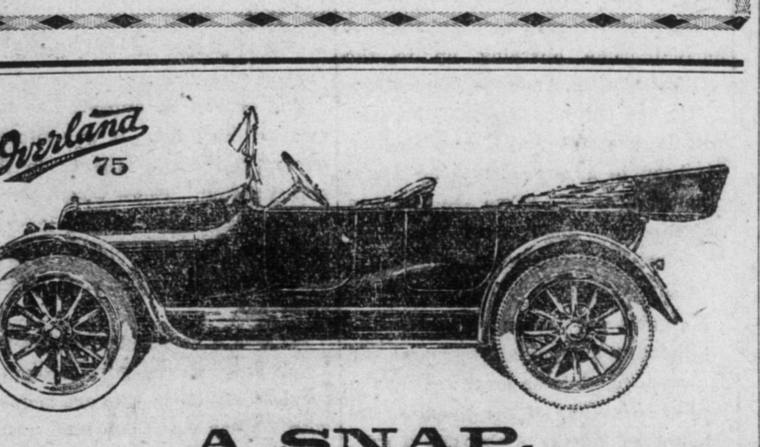


RED CROSS LINE.
