Boston, July 31 .- Augustus F. Harvey, actuary of the Missouri state insurance department, and James M. Lewis, of the same place, who have been investigating the affairs of the Massachusetts Benefit Life Association, have made public their report. It shows that all of the policies issued from 1879, when organization was incorporated, till the enactment of statutes of 1888, relating to insurance upon the assessment plan, were illegal, and that the illegality of the business of the company prior to 1885 seems to have been condoned and legalized by the Legislature.
