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CHAPTER OF INSTRUCTION WAS HELD AT STRATHROY

Mark Degree Was Conferred By Ex-Comp. Finlay Marshall.

A very successful chapter of instruction was held at Strathroy on Tuesday.

At a meeting called by Rt. Ex-Comp. George Sutherland, of Theford, superintendent of London district, No. 12, the Mark degree was conferred by Ex-Comp. Finlay Marshall and the officers of London Chapter, No. 150. In the evening the officers of Beaver Lodge took charge of the meeting and received the officers of the Grand Chapter, Rt. Ex-Comp. George Sutherland and then, in the name of the district, presented Rt. Ex-Comp. E. W. Hunsinger, of St. Thomas, with a past grand superintendency of regalia for the very able manner in which he had performed the duties of superintendent during 1908. The Royal Arch degree was then conferred by Rt. Ex-Comp. J. H. Angus, past grand of Beaver Lodge Chapter. Companies were present from St. Thomas, Parkhill, Aylmer, London and other places, and at the conclusion of the regular business, partook of a banquet.
