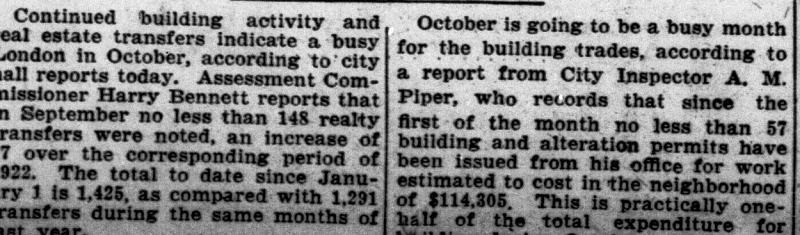


Lloyd George Arrives In New York En Route To Canada

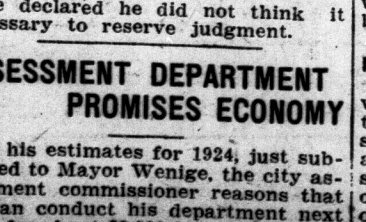
