extent to the labors of the editor. Instead of publishing monthly, we will after the first of January ISSUE THE RECORD TWICE A MONTH. The amount of matter and general appearance will be the same as at present, that is, a number consisting of twolve pages will be published on the first and third Saturday of each month. In other respects our present plan will be generally adhered to. We will endeavor to give a summary of the more interesting items of news each fortnight, which we find is generally acceptable to our readers, and may be useful afterwards for reference. We will dispense with the cover, and by doing so sacrifice £15 or £20 a year from advertisements. Objections have been made by some of our readers to advertisements appearing in our sheet. This is a matter of opinion; at all events none will appear in our future numbers, unless those in connection with our Church or some religious object. Our expense will be greater in this new form, arising from the fact of a double instead of a single publication, as well as the labor of addressing twice instead of once a

To meet this expense, we have concluded to make a very small addition to our price, viz., seven mence half-penny a year. For 24 numbers of the Record then, the price will be 3s. 14d. instead of half a dollar. We are certain that none of our friends will object to this trifling addition, when we inform them: that the Record at its present price does not pay for paper and printing, and every year a considerable sum has had to be raised from foreign sources to defray current expenses. These sources for the future we have been given to understand will not be available, so ·that we have no resource but to fall upon the generosity of our readers.
