Mr. Berlis, who was born in Toronto, Ontario on April 8, 1914, educated at the University of Toronto and Osgoode Hall. He served the Royal Canadian Navy from 1943 to 1946. Mr. Berlis joined the artment of External Affairs in June 1947 and subsequently served Geneva. He was appointed Counsellor in Rome in 1956 and in January 2 he was appointed Canadian High Commissioner to Tanganyika. In tember 1962 he was concurrently accredited as Canadian High missioner to Uganda.

Mr. Berlis is married and has two children.

Mr. Houde, who was born in Quebec City on September 9, 1922, educated at Quebec Seminary and Laval University. He joined the artment of External Affairs in 1949 and subsequently served abroad Brussels and Athens. In 1957 Mr. Houde was appointed First Secrey, Paris (N.A.C. and O.E.E.C.), in 1961 he was appointed Chargé Ifaires a.i. and Consul in Montevideo and in 1964 he returned to Department in Ottawa.
