INTERNATIONAL TRADE BROCHURE RELEASED

Other documents on trade negotiations will be published shortly. They will include pamphlets discussing provincial and territorial interests in trade liberalization, particularly with regard to the U.S., and sectoral notes describing industry and consumer interests in free trade.
