PRAYERS.

Mr. Fulton, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House, —Copy of supplementary correspondence, including copies of resolutions passed by the Quebec Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council, exchanged between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Province of Quebec, concerning the amendment of section 99 of the British North America Act, 1867.

By unanimous consent, it was ordered that the said correspondence and resolutions be printed as an appendix to the *Votes and Proceedings*.

Mr. Peters, seconded by Mr. Martin (Timmins), by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-52, An Act to amend the Canada Elections Act (Publication of Straw Poll Results), which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The following bill from the Senate was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House:

Bill S-3, An Act to repeal certain Fisheries Laws of Newfoundland.—Mr. Churchill.
