

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk, as follows:—

1. Page 1, line 7. For "Sidney" substitute "Sydney".
2. Page 2, line 20. Leave out the word "upon".
3. Page 4, line 11. For "2 George V, Chapter 33 of the Province of Ontario" substitute "Chapter 183 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1914,".
