*STUDY OF AIRPORT EXPANSION, TORONTO

Question No. 616—Mr. Nesbitt:

1. What studies is the Department of Transport currently undertaking with regard to expanding the airport facilities in the Metropolitan Toronto area?

2. Is the Department studying the possibility of constructing a second airport in the Toronto area, as an alternative to expanding the existing airport?

3. Has the Minister of Transport authorized a study into the possibility of building a second airport in the Toronto area, specifically on Lake Ontario?

4. If the answer to Part 3 is yes, how does the Department intend to estimate the cost of making the required land fill, necessary to the construction of such an airport?

5. Is the Department giving study to the feasibility of building floating runways for such an airport?

Hon. Paul Hellyer (Minister of Transport): The answer to the first part of the question is that the Department of Transport has completed a study in depth with respect to the expansion of Toronto international airport. This study involved a consortium of recognized consultants as well as officials of
