No. 827—*Mr. Burton*

1. What are the names of the Chairman and members of the Canada Grains Council and on what date was each appointed and when does the appointment expire?
2. What committees and other subsidiary bodies have been appointed by the Canada Grains Council and what is the name and address of each member of such body?
3. What special studies have been undertaken by the Canada Grains Council and in each case, who is undertaking the study?
