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CATTLE MARKET

CLEARED YESTERDAY

Sheep, Lambs, Calves and
Hogs About Steady
Thursday.

Receipts of live stock at the Union
yards yesterday were 26 carloads; 365
cattle, 1226 hogs, 35 sheep and lambs and
28 calves.

Trade was slow with prices reported
unchanged. But there were few cattle
that reached \$5 or over during the week,
as will be seen by sales reported during
the week.

Sheep, lambs, hogs and calves have
remained steady and generally firm all
week.

At the close of the market all offer-
ings were reported as being cleaned up.
