

THE SENATE OF CANADA.

BILL Y.

An Act respecting The Grand Council of the Catholic Mutual Benefit Association of Canada.

WHEREAS Thomas Smith, of the city of Ottawa, in the  
county of Carleton, civil servant, William J. Sutherland,  
of the town of Smiths Falls, in the county of Lanark,  
engineer, Jean M. Briand and Joseph Larue, both  
of the said city of Ottawa, civil servants, members of The  
Grand Council of the Catholic Mutual Benefit Association  
of Canada in good standing who were admitted to said  
Association before 1st November, 1907, have by their  
petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth,  
and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:  
Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and  
consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada,  
enacts as follows:—

1. Chapter 136 of the statutes of 1914 (first session)  
is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:—

“2. The preceding section of this Act shall not come into  
force or have any effect until the Grand Trustees call a  
convention for general business of said Association and  
submit thereto the increased rates, liens and options  
proposed by them.”
