HAMILTON HAPPENINGS

ARRESTED FOR FAILING TO REPORT FOR DEPORTATION

Four Alien Tailors Will Probably Be Given a Chance to Get Over to the United States.

HAMILTON, Oct. 26.—(Special)—The four alien tailors, who failed to report for deportation after they were declared to be in the country illegally, were arrested to-day. They are three men and one woman, the men being Samuel Wolfe, Jos. Abrams and Morris Herman. The first two, with the woman, were arrested here, but Herman is in custody in Toronto.

Blake Robertson, the government inspector, who has been here for several days conducting an investigation, it is believed, will have Wolfe charged before the magistrate with entering the country after he was deported and for aiding others to enter, in addition to eluding an officer. However, it is likely that all will be given a chance to get over into the United States, and stay there.

The death occurred to-night of Miss Lewis, sister of A. M. Lewis, barrister. Miss Fletcher died at the Aged Women's Home, 300 East Barton-street, was struck by a street car near the corner of St. Matthews-avenue and East Barton-street, and when picked up it was feared he was dead. He was running across the street and did not notice the approaching car. He was thrown clear of the tracks and rendered unconscious by the fall on the pavement. He was taken to the City Hospital, and will recover.

The court of revision heard the appeals against the assessment in ward one this afternoon and to-night.
