TO RELIEVE CONGESTION OF POPULATION.
That congestion of population can be sensibly relieved by improved transportation facilities is, in the opinion of John W. Paris, of New York, a palpable fallacy. In a letter to The Record and Guide of that city, Mr. Paris says:

"That congestion should be relieved goes without question. If we will but get at the cause of congestion we could most readily get at the means of relieving the same. It is well and generally recognized that the laborer will live no farther from his place of labor than he can be easily walked, unless he is compelled to do so.

"The great congested area of this city is found east of Fourth-avenue and south of Third-avenue; another congested area which has more recently grown up lies to the west of Eighth-avenue and to the north of Forty-second-street. We will but look for the location of our great industries, enterprises where the majority of our laboring class finds employment, we will find these to the south of Forty-second-street and to the west of Fourth-avenue. The sections therefore which lie nearest to this great employment centre are the great congestion centres.

"The next question which presents itself is the reason why these factories are to be found in this restricted area. It is because of freight traffic. All of the great steamship lines have their docks either on the east or west shores of the North River. All of the great railroad lines have their terminals on the east or west side of the North River. These great factories and warehouses are located in that territory most adjacent to the freight terminals of both ship line and railroad.

"The city and the public service commission have been giving all of their time and expending millions of money in devising additional rapid transit lines for the carrying of passengers, on the theory that such lines would relieve congestion. With all the lines built up to the present time congestion has not been relieved. If the city and public service commission would take up seriously the question of rapid, convenient and cheap freight traffic in the city, along which the factories could be persuaded to locate, and thus the distribution of our places of employment we have in a most natural way, and without any additional effort on the part of anybody, distributed our population in living accommodations."
