Torontos Have Seven Points Lead Bisons Beat Montreal on Sunday

McManus Out of Game Owing to Injury Said to Have Been Received Here—Double Headers Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

MONTREAL, Aug. 4.—(Special).—The Bisons and Royals were scheduled to play a double-header here today, but a heavy rainstorm came on in the second inning of the opening game, and after waiting for half an hour, Umpire Owens called the contest off and announced that there would be a game a half hour later. When the cancellation was made the score was 2 to 1 in favor of the locals, who had found Tozer for three timely singles in their half of the opening inning. The same two pitchers, Stanley and Tozer, were opposed to each other in the second game, but the Buffalo player had the better of the struggle, and the result was that the visitors won rather handily by 3 runs to 1. Stanley lasted six innings, but he was so wild that Manager Moran put Herost in the box. The big pitcher's arm was in good working order, and in the three innings he pitched he fanned three of the Bisons.

The birds' trouble started in the first inning. Stanley nailed a fast grounder by Nattress, but three timely singles by Tozer, Nattress and Getman sent the visitors to left and the run came. A fast double play, Stanley to Tozer, retired Getman and White, and Murray struck out. The Royals evened up in the second. Corcoran drew transportation and Shean and Stanley sent him over the plate with singles. This was the only inning in which the Birds threatened to send the Bisons down to defeat. The visitors clinched the game in the third. McAllister hit safely to centre and Tozer walked. Nattress singled, scored McAllister, and Getman's out to Needham did the same by Tozer. The Buffalos added another to their string in the sixth on a pass to White and a clean double to centre by Murray. Murray's single and McConnell's triple in the eighth gave them their lead, and McConnell hit the ball to deep right and tried to make the circuit, but fast relieving Tozer, who had been in the game on account of a bad foot, and Needham held down the left garden. McAllister, who has been laid up for a week by a strained back, going to right field. McConnell could not play because of an injured arm. He and the other Montreal players claim that Phyle deliberately struck him in the face with the bat in the Toronto series in the Queen City to prevent him throwing the ball to second to intercept a base runner. McConnell will be out of the game for some days. Hill wrenched his ankle sliding into place. The Bisons and Royals will play double-headers here Monday and Tuesday.
