Sir,-

I beg to refer you to letter of the MIST
July 1906 No. II9322-A and to inform you that we
had the survey made of the addition to the
Fisher River Indian Reserve, Man, therein referred to.
I beg to enclose herewith a blue print copy of the
plan of the survey. A plan on tracing cloth will
also be sent to you in a separate parcel.

You will note that the addition in Township
28 Range I W.P.M. consists of sections I5 and I6
and the South halves of sections 2I and 22 being an
area of 1920 acres.

Fisher River Reserved plot of land bordered red containing I60 acres. This portion of land was surveyed at the request of the Indian Chief and Council as it is occupied and has been in the possession for about five years, of a former non-treaty Indian named Peter Murdock, who has been recently admitted as a member of the Fisher River Band. The said Peter Murdock has a good house on the lot 20° x 14° one and a half stories, shingled roof, five windows kitchen lean-to and has also a stable and graden. It is hoped that your Department will concur in allowing the said plot of I60 acres to be added to the Fisher River Indian Reserve.
