

Mr. Jones' First Report.

In Commissioner Jones' report he pointed out that for the first time in the steps taken by the department of agriculture which had made it possible to grow enough wheat to feed the province for a year.

It was the aim of the department to work on a strictly non-political basis for greater production, better quality and profitable markets.

Referring to the federal government proposal to establish cold storage facilities and an abattoir in Halifax, the minister said that he had advocated the choice of St. John as the site and was seeking the co-operation of the St. John Board of Trade in achieving this.

Mr. Jones' First Report.

In Commissioner Jones' report he pointed out that for the first time in the history of the water department an excess of expenditures over income is reported, this being due to the decision of the council to replace cast iron pipe with cement pipe. Expenditure for pipe not provided for amounted to \$29,585.56, while the over-expenditure on account of sewerage maintenance and hydrants was \$28,697,61, which was charged to water maintenance account.

With the exception of the chapter of accidents which occurred on June 19 and 20, when three leaks appeared, very littie inconvenience was caused the public. The cost of this portion of the service was \$6,812.70.

off and lettings on cost \$2,891.76. "The expenditure for fire hydrant maintenance was \$5,145.75. "Our inspector answered 184 anarms during the year and found hydrants in good order each time. "Three new hydrants were placed and fifteen were renewed from one-way to three-way with 6-inch pipe connections instead of 4-inch. "I venture to express the belief that the citizen who takes the trouble to read over and carefully consider the information contained in this report, which has been so well arranged by George D. Martin, the chief clerk of the department, will agree with me in saying that the clerical duties of this office have been most faithfully, efficiently and satisfactorily performed. "Two months is too brief a period of time to judge of results of my administration of this department, but I trust that when I shall again he celled on to report on its activities, the public will have no reason to regret the confidence so unmistakably expressed in my election to this office on Dec. 30 last."


