MONDAY, June 23d. 1834.

THE introductory Sermon was preached by Elder James Munro, from 1 Corinthians 15. 25—*For He must reign, till He hath put all enemies under his feet.*

A Collection was taken in aid of Missions, in addition to one taken on the preceding Sabbath.

Elder Munro being Moderator the past year, at the close of the public exercises addressed the throne of grace for divine direction.

Elder Munro was chosen Moderator of the present Session ; Elder William Chipman, Clerk ; Elder Richard McLearn, Assistant Clerk ; and Elders Crawley and Tupper, were chosen to read the Letters.

Elder Henry Kendall, from Topsham, Messenger from the Bowdoinham Association, was requested to take a seat with us— as were also, Elder J. Stevens, from Chepody, and Brother Silas T. Rand, Licentiate from 1st Cornwallis Church.

Adjourned to meet again at two o'clock, P. M.
