- Q.88 During the period that you were out of uniform you hid it in a sack?
- A.88 Yes, sir.
- Did any damage come to the uniform? Q.89
- A.89
- Did you ever attempt to damage your uniform or lose it or dispose of it? 9.90 A.90
- No, sir. I was going to keep it all the time.
- As to your age, you state that some of the other boys in the Company had remarked that you looked rather young. Did you tell them your true age? Q.91
- A.91 No, sir. I told them the same as I had told the Army -- 19.
- Some Officer whose name you don't remember told you you were under age and told you you were quite definitely out of luck as far as going Overseas was con-Q.92 cerned?
- A.92 Yes, sir,
