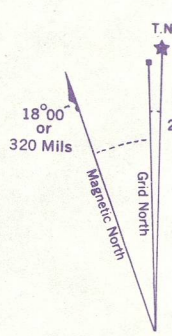

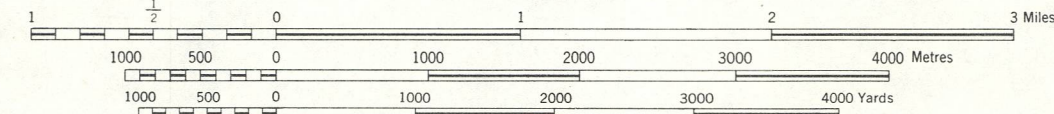

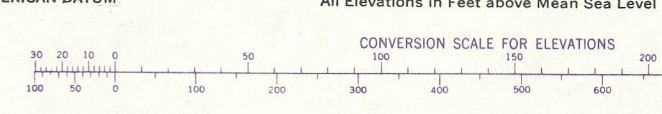
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 19° 03' WEST
