

FRANCE FINANCIALLY SOUND DESPITE STRAIN

FRENCH CHAMBER VOTES NEW WAR CREDIT OF NEARLY EIGHT BILLIONS OF FRANCS

Paris, March 17 (6.30 p. m.).—Although France spent more than 25,000,000,000 francs in 1915, the financial situation is satisfactory, thanks to the French internal loan, which is being maintained above the rate of issue, said Felix Ribot, minister of finance, during a discussion of the appropriations required for the second quarter of 1916, in the Chamber of Deputies today. With but one dissenting vote the chamber adopted the credit of 7,800,000,000 francs for the second quarter. This is equivalent to a daily expenditure of \$7,000,000 francs.

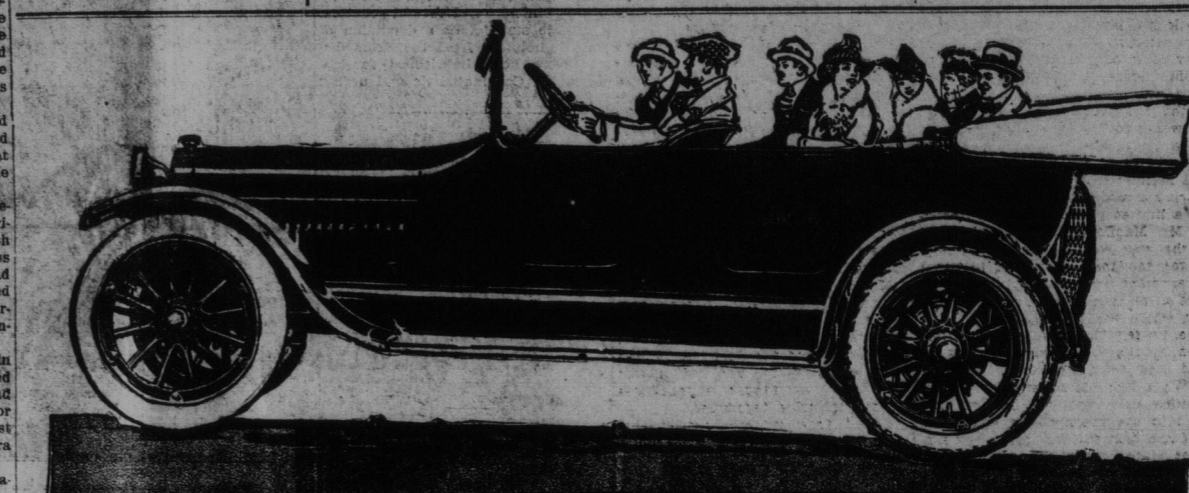
