MAKING SOIL SURVEY OF LANDS IN NEW BRUNSWICK

The Work is of Supreme Importance and Will Tend to Encourage the Better Class of Settlers.

In the survey of forests and land classification on the Crown Lands of the province, which is being carried out under the direction of Mr. G. H.
