Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 19th Instant enclosing a sketch Plan showing crossing of the French River, opposite the Lower French River Indian Reserve and asking for information in regard thereto, I beg leave to say that no individual or corporation has acquired by purchase, or otherwise, from this Department any rights to this crossing or to the lands on the Reserve touched by the crossing.

The Reserve in question is not occupied by Indians.

The Department has no Plan of the District for distribution, but you may be able to secure one upon application to Mr. Aubrey White, the Assistant Commissioner of Crown Lands, Toronto.
