He was followed by Rev. W. J. Taylor, in a long and useful Incumbency, extending from October 1879 till May 1888. Mr. Taylor was a good preacher and a diligent pastor. He accomplished a great work in building up the parish. He was distinguished for his horticultural tastes and love of flowers. The Rectory grounds at Wardsville were a sight to see, during his Incumbency of nine years.
