ADDENDUM.

NOTE.—It should be observed that at the time of the dispersion of the great Huron nation, among those who fled from the Iroquois Westward were two considerable bodies, who sought shelter among the other Indian nations at different points, and were afterwards heard of co-operating with the latter in the various events, which subsequently took place. Representatives of these bodies are still to be found in the West. It was because of the shelter afforded to the Hurons that the Iroquois attacked and destroyed the Ottawas and the Eries.
