An Act to provide for the more speedy recovery of small debts in places where no Commissioners' Court exists, in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS in those parts of Lower Canada where no Commissioners' Preamble. Court exists, great loss and inconvenience have arisen from the want of some more speedy mode of recovering small debts than now exists, and it is fitting and expedient to supply that want; Therefore Her Majesty, 5 &c., enacts as follows:
