

Nagana 2^d April 1844.

Sir,

I have the honor to enclose herewith a letter I received on the 30th Ult. from Mr. William Stewart of the Grand River in this District, which I shall feel obliged by your laying before His Excellency the Governor General. It may be within the recollection of His Excellency that in June last a similar attempt to obtain from Government the confirmation of ^{referred to in Mr. Stewart's letter} an Indian Grant by the same parties, was made which if successful would have been the ruin of Mr. Stewart. Unfortunately the parties are all connected as well by marriage as by blood, which renders it a matter of delicacy on my part, who am connected with both, to have any thing whatever to say in the matter. But as it would appear there are many combining in their efforts to deprive Mr. Stewart of the result of his industry
