for the greater part reincides with a readway previously recerved by the Department for the province. This latter readway is chosen on plan of survey by V.T. Thompson, Delese, dated
7th April, 1905, a depy of which is recorded in the Surveys
Branch of the Department of Indian Affairs under No. 713.
As the province relinquishes all claim to the last mentioned
readway, it is considered the transfer may be made without
compensations.
