Owing to the necessity of conserving funds and the impossibility of obtaining a fair attendance, our annual convention was not held in 1932. There have been several inquiries as to whether a convention is to be held in 1933, and, if so, when.

With the information available it has been found impossible to reach a definite conclusion in the matter and it has been decided to appeal to the membership for advice. If 150 members and supporters were to indicate their willingness to attend or send representatives, it would be worth while to go ahead, particularly, as the proceedings of the convention would be available to all members whether in attendance or not. We are therefore sending you herewith an inquiry card which we trust you will fill out and return.

The convention would provide opportunity for those interested in problems of taxation and civic expenditure, as well as for civic and governmental treasury and accounting officers and municipal assessment officials, to meet in separate and joint conferences.

Registration fee for members or delegates would be \$1.00 and for others \$2.00 including in each case a lunch ticket and one copy of the proceedings. Additional copies of the proceedings would be \$1.00 each for members and \$2.00 each for non-members.

The Royal Winter Fair is to be held in November from the 22nd to the 29th both inclusive, so that those deciding to attend the Convention could take in the Fair during their visit in Toronto. An early reply on the card attached will be greatly appreciated.
