promptly when you are making annuity payments this year upon all the day schools on the reserves in your agency. The Department is aware that some of the schools may be closed at the time of your visit, but you should report on the condition and equipment of the buildings. grounds, etc., and gather what information you can from outside sources as to the character of the work being performed by the teachers. These reports will be expected as soon as possible after the completion of your trip.

It is also noted that your reports have not been received even on the day schools which are in the immediate neighborhood of Norway House. These at least should be reported upon regularly and all others as often as you visit the reserves.
