As the Hudson's Bay Company will pay for almost every thing on the trip, it is considered that it should not be an anxiety for Mr. Bennett to have a large advance for travelling expenses, but the Department would like you to state what you think should be sent.

It would be well to give written instructions to Mr. Bennett, and the Department would be pleased to receive a copy thereof as well as a copy of the agreement with the Hudson's Bay Company for transport.

You should at once forward a requisition for whatever stationery, blank pay-lists, etc., which Mr. Bennett will require and they will be forwarded per express.
