Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 14th instant, No. 40-B, in which you recommend that \$50.00, being a years rent, be granted to Mr. Jacobsen as compensation for land lost from his lease in the Belle Coole Indian Reserve on account of the survey lines cutting off a piece of land included in his lease, I have to request you to be good enough to state whether this is the same matter referred to in letter to you of September 27, last, and whether the matter dealt with in the said letter has been adjusted.

Kindly obtain and forward to the Department a report from Mr. Green relating to the above mentioned survey in order that the Department may have the facts before it on which to base a decision as to whether the payment requested by Mr. Jacobsen is to be made.
